

### **Year 3 learning log menu of activities. Autumn term - 2020**

Write/create a biography/fact file about someone who inspires you - what can you find out about them and their life? See if you can present your learning in an interesting way.

Create an explanation on how a fossil is formed.

Create a piece of digital art that represents Autumn.

Write a diary entry based on a special day that you have had. It could be based on your birthday, a religious day which you celebrated or a holiday you had. Remember to try and include some features of a diary.

Create a fact file about Leicester. Try and make it interesting and eye catching.

Start a maths dictionary and can you find some different words that have the same meaning as addition and subtraction.

Create some kindness rules and think how you can present these using 'word' document. E.g. using wordart

Compose a prayer giving thanks for all the good things in your life. You could give thanks for your health, family, friends, education, home, clothing, food etc. You can choose to give thanks to any god of any religion. If you do not have a religion, you might want to write a poem or letter to someone who has given you good things in your life for which you are grateful.

Create a piece of work about one of our values – inclusive, responsibility, courage, perseverance, empathy, aspiration, curiosity. You could write a story, a fact file, a poster – the choice is yours!

Find out about one of the festivals that is celebrated during Autumn. You could research Harvest, Diwali, Navratri, Eid or Halloween. Present your research in an interesting way.
